## THE ONE & ONLY ROPE OFF - \$240 per site (available to Festival 4-day ticket holders only)

If you want to stake your claim on a great camp site, come along to the one & only rope off starting at 7:00am Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025. You are welcome to camp from this date on or stake you claim and return later to setup and stay, please keep in mind that amenities will not be available until Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2025. If you're not staying from this weekend don't forget to bring your rope & stakes to mark out your site in any of our general camping areas – Areas 1 (5-Ways Sth), 2 (5-Ways Nth), 3 (Bellbird Bend), 4 (Poulsen's Flat & Overflow), 5 (Poulsen's Hill), 6 (Feral Hill), & 8 (Blue Gum Ridge). ### **Camp Sites**

- Each rope off ticket allows for a site up to 100m2 per rope off ticket. e.g 10x10, 9x11,8x12 etc
- A maximum of 4 rope off tickets can be purchased and only available to Festival 4-Day ticket holders.
- All tickets and areas roped off will be checked by the camp wardens after the rope-off weekend.
- The Rope-off is only available to Festival 4-day ticket holders.
- A maximum of 6 adults can occupy a rope off site.
- A rain-proof (laminated or in a plastic sleeve) copy of your camping ticket (NOT festival ticket) must be displayed in a prominent position.
- If you are not staying, please ensure your rope-off ticket is well secured. We suggest you use rope and secure your rope and ticket to the ground to prevent cattle and weather from taking down you're your marked out area.
- Camp wardens will roughly mark out the site to approximately 100m2. Due to the non-uniform layout of the roads and campgrounds small sites will be marked with an S. Do not rope-off a larger area than marked as this will significantly affect all other marked campsites.
- You cannot rope off in the "We Rope Off For You" designated areas listed: Poulsen's Place, Poulsen's Flat, Poulsen's Flat Overflow, Outstation, Alfords Pocket or any other GMM designated area. CLICK HERE FOR MAP
- DO NOT ENTER WATER BODIES, IF YOU ENTER ANY WATER BODY THEN IT IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.



# No pets at Rope-off!!!

## Rope-off procedure 2025

- Bring your ropes and pegs and a laminated rope off pass.
- You will need a rope off ticket to enter the campground to rope off your site.
- Queuing will officially commence on Thursday 7<sup>th</sup> August 2025. Please see notes below.
- Camping will only be allowed in the queuing areas. Banjos and Nashville.
- Camp wardens will provide patrons with a colour coded numbered ticket corresponding to their
  preferred campground on a first come first served basis. Please note once you receive your
  numbered ticket you will be required to remain onsite until the commencement of the rope off.
- Patrons will then be asked to queue as described below.
- No vehicles are to be parked outside the queuing areas.
- No roping off will be allowed before 7.00am on Saturday August 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025.
- Camp wardens will direct the queue at 7.00am from two stations in an orderly manner.
- We ask that all patrons be patient and courteous.
- Please note: Gympie Music Muster has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY FOR AGGRESSIVE BEHAVIOUR Any aggressive or abusive behaviour towards staff, camp wardens, volunteers, or other patrons, at the discretion of GML, will result in forfeiture of your right to attend the festival including any camping.
- Please follow the directions of the camp wardens.
- A coffee van will be available on Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2025. (Rope Off day)
- Portable toilets will be provided for the rope-off weekend.

#### Poulsen's Hill and Poulsen's Flat (Area 4 & 5)

Queue in Banjos once full you will be directed to the Red Gate Bus stop.

### 5-Ways Sth (Area 1), 5-Ways Nth (Area 2), Bellbird Bend (Area 3) and Feral Hill (Area 6)

Queue in Nashville Park once full you will be directed to the The Outstation.

## Blue Gum Ridge (Area 8)

Queue at the Red Gate Bus stop.

PLEASE NOTE: There is no queueing on Heathcote Rd. If you come from Gympie via Heathcote Rd, you will be held until all other queues have been released. Please come to the site via Amamoor Creek Rd.

Once all allocated queuing areas are full the Camp Wardens will then direct further queuing to Alfords.



### **GENERAL CAMPGROUND RULES APPLY**

### **Camping**

- Campsites are approximately 100m2.
- Maximum 6 people per camp site.
- Tents must be at least 2m apart.
- No dogs in the campground. This applies from 31 July 2025. Certified assistance dogs only are allowed refer to the Animals at the Muster fact sheet.
- Alfords Flat, Alfords Pocket and Blue Gum Ridge are quiet camping ONLY No loud music/parties or whip cracking allowed between 10pm – 7am.
- Generators are not permitted between 10pm and 6am. Please consider your neighbours.
- All amenities will gradually be available from August 23, 2025.
- Dump points are available in Nashville, Poulsen's Hill & Poulsen's Flat
- Campers must vacate campsite by Tuesday 2 September 2025.
- DO NOT ENTER WATER BODIES, IF YOU ENTER ANY WATER BODY THEN IT IS AT YOUR OWN RISK.

### **Vehicles**

- Speed limit is 10km/hr.
- No unregistered vehicles are to be used on site. i.e. golf carts, side by sides unless authorised by GML. Mobility scooters are permitted.
- All road rules apply.
- No vehicle movement in the campgrounds between 5pm and 7am unless you are leaving the festival. Emergencies excluded. GML accepts no responsibility for any personal injury or property damage caused by patron vehicles.
- Disability parking at the bus turnaround is for day ticket holders with wheelchairs.
- Disability campers are to use the disability courtesy bus.
- Cars parked in the disabled carpark without the appropriate stickers will be towed.

#### **Fires**

- No fires between 9am and 4pm. All fires will be extinguished during the day.
- Further fire bans may apply on advice from QFS.
- All fires must be contained within a fire ring.
- 4m distance must be kept between a fire and tents or vehicles.
- Nothing is to be put in a fire ring that doesn't burn. i.e. metal.

## **Emergencies**

- Make yourself familiar with the closest emergency meeting point. These sites are marked with a name and number to quote in the event of an emergency.
- Medical emergencies: In the first instance call the on-site Medic. The number is displayed on the emergency call point sign. If no response, then call 000.
- On-site medic is available from Saturday 23 August 2025.
- A Security number is also displayed for all other emergencies.
